Epiphany/Baptism of our Lord

Epiphany ("manifestation") of our Lord, January 6th, is more ancient than our Christmas and Advent celebrations. Western Churches, both Protestant and Catholic, traditionally celebrate Epiphany with the story of the coming of the Magi, and the presentation of gifts to the Lord. Eastern and Orthodox Churches have traditionally celebrated Epiphany with the story of Christ's baptism in the Jordan by John, along with baptisms of new believers and the reaffirmation of baptism. The season of Epiphany then focuses on the early life and ministry of Jesus, leading up to the season of Lent.

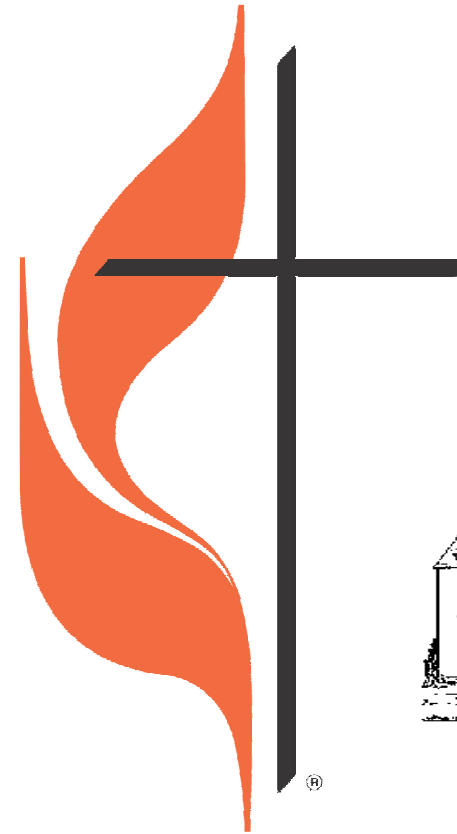
